M.I.S.C.A. Academic All-State Guidelines for Applications

*Girls and Boys application deadline is the last Friday in March.

Directions:

1. Athletes must have participated and finished the season in good standing to be eligible.
2. Cumulative GPA is to be used including the last full semester in which credit was earned.
3. Round GPA to the nearest hundredth
4. Recorded scores may not be higher than 4.0. GPA higher than 4.0 reverts to 4.0.
5. The application is to list the entire varsity team and average the GPA for each of these individuals to determine the team GPA. Must have a minimum of 10 athletes to apply for the Team Scholar Award.
6. Use 90% of team members to calculate your team GPA.
7. If the program cannot field a complete team, it may not apply.
8. Applications will require coach, administrator and registrar signatures.
9. A complete list of team winners will be posted on the M.I.S.C.A. website at www.misca.org.
10. Top Ten Certificates will be sent to the head coach for each member of their team.

Step One:

1. List all Varsity athletes, the required minimum number is 10.

Step Two:

2. List the varsity team athletes by name, grade, and accumulative grade point average. Round to the nearest hundredth. Use 90% of the team's athletes to find the team's GPA, ex. 20 team members, use 18 members to find a total.

Step Three:

3. Add up 90% of the grade point averages to find the **total**.

Step Four:

4. Divide the **total** by the number of members used to determine the TEAM COMPOSITE GRADE POINT AVERAGE. Round to the nearest hundredth. This average is used to determine if your team qualifies for the M.I.S.C.A. Academic All State Award. This figure must rank in the team top ten to be All State.

The head coach and the High School Athletic Director should review the names of the team members listed on the application and sign verification of the required participation. The High School Principal must verify the accuracy of the grade point average for each student listed on the application form.

The deadline for postmark is the last Friday in March.
