

M.I.S.C.A. Academic All-State Team Award: Guidelines for Applications

Directions for the online application:

1. Student athletes must have participated and finished the season in good standing to be eligible.
2. Cumulative GPA is to be used including the last full semester/trimester in which credit was earned.
3. GPA used for calculations must be unweighted.
4. Round GPA to the nearest hundredth
5. Recorded scores may not be higher than 4.0.
6. You must have a minimum of 10 student athletes to apply for the MISCA Academic All-State Team Award.
7. If the program cannot field a complete team, it may not apply.
8. By sending an application, you are verifying its authenticity.
9. A complete list of team winners will be posted on the M.I.S.C.A. website.
10. Teams above a 3.50 will earn Academic-All State status for their current season.

Step One

-The required minimum number for this award is 10 student athletes per team. List the varsity team athletes by name, and grade. Round to the nearest hundredth. Example: 1. Steve Bowyer Junior 2. Ian Kobes, Junior, etc.

Step Two

-List all of the GPA's of the athletes listed above. List a GPA then press return so that the GPAs are in a single file column. Please view the example below for reference.

Step Three:

-Use all of the team's varsity athletes to find the team's GPA. Add all the GPAs together and put the total below. (Example: 104.55)

Step Four:

-Divide the total from above by the number of members to determine the TEAM COMPOSITE GRADE POINT AVERAGE. (Example: 104.55 divided by 29 varsity athletes). Please round to the nearest hundredth (Example: 3.61) This average is used to determine if your team qualifies for the M.I.S.C.A. Academic All-State Team Award. This average must be at a 3.50 or higher to be All State in each division. Please put the cumulative average below.

Coaches will type their name, title, and school name below, which will serve as an electronic signature. Only official members of a school staff are allowed to submit applications. All coaches must be MISCA members in order to apply. By typing your name, title, and school name you agree to all terms and policies outlined for this award and agree that the information entered is accurate and in good standing with your administration and school district.
