# **Action Items Discussed:**

- Should we approve that the general fund be used to cover the cost (\$5.50 per member coach) of being included in the MHSCA's new umbrella insurance policy. After much discussion it was resolved that no decision would be made until after Bob Crosby attends the next MHSCA meeting in the near future. It is our hope that we can discuss this again at our January meeting. If Bob discovers we need to act now on this he will communicate via email to the Exec Board.
- Awards Awards Luncheon at Clinic and State Meet Awards

It was decided that the new Awards Committee Head, Cory Bergen, will send a congratulatory letter to all award winners (Mann/Harlan/Outstanding Service/Zone COY). This letter will also invite them to the Awards Luncheon at the Fall Clinic. Cory will be responsible to gather the needed bios and photos for the winners of the Mann, Harlan, and Outstanding Service awards. The Zone VP's are responsible to get the bios and photos of the COY in their zone and also submit any information to Cory about coaches that have received other awards. Zone VP's need to strongly encourage their Zone COY to attend the Fall Clinic and Awards Luncheon.

The Awards Chair will need to type up and present the bios for the Mann, Harlan, and Outstanding awards at the fall business meeting. At the January Exec Board meeting the nominees will be finalized using the suggestions of nominees from the fall business meeting. The Exec Board will also need to finalize if nominees remain on the ballot for 2 or 3 years.

The Awards Chair will be responsible to have Swim Coach of the Year ballots printed, distributed at each State Meet, collected, and tallied. Awards Chair will also need to make sure NISCA All America certificates are given to coaches who have swimmers that equal or better the consideration time standards. Awards Chair will also distribute All State certificates to member coaches. Awards Chair needs to take a photo of the winners of: Swimmer and Diver of the Year and Swimming and Diving Coach of the Year. He will need help to distribute, collect and tally at each State Meet. Mike Torrey, Greg Phill, and Dennis Hill agreed to do this at D1 and Mike Rado and Dave Z agreed to help at D2.

- Greg Phill will send this year's clinic speakers Thank You notes and make sure their rooms are complimentary.
- Butch and Jim asked Gina to consider making the rules meeting mandatory again. The rules meetings are good opportunities for MISCA to encourage membership and clinic attendance.
- I will need to send out several emails and a post card next summer to encourage and inform past members to reenroll membership and register for the clinic. I will also need to email Zone VP's the membership list so they can encourage coaches in their area to join.
- Clinic Speakers Greg's goal is to have next year's speakers lined up by the January meeting. It was the consensus of the group to have at least one Michigan HS coach talk, Dennis Hill for 2006, and continue a coaches' panel with a Q and A. Dennis and Rick will contact NISCA to see if they will sponsor a nationally known high school coach to speak.
- EMU diving needs EMU needs \$3000 to update their diving equipment. Much discussion was had about how to get these funds to EMU. It was decided the following contacts will be made:
