Action Items Discussed:

Treasurer

- We currently have about \$18,000 in the bank. We have bills still for MHSCA (3200), NISCA (600), board meeting(500), a few misc (300-600). Plus we still want to leave \$5000 in the acct as a rollover for next membership year.
- Voted on adding addition money to the scholoarship fund after May 15, anything over \$5000 in our account will be added to the fund.

 - o Coaches took wine/liquor from the social and it gets charged to Shannon's bill, we need to ask the hotel to remove all the alcohol from the room once it's over.
 - o The business meeting always runs long and cuts into the speakers time. Start the meeting at 9am, start the luncheon at 12:15pm. If we have topics that come up perhaps finish the topic/conversation at the end of the luncheon if time is available.
- Gregg has asked Speedo for Ken Anderson, David Marsh, David Salo, and Ray Looze. He's asked Speedo to get us the names by mid/late May so we can post on our website and advertise.

MISCA Meet

- Dates EMU-Oct24th and Feb 13th OU Oct 10th and Feb 13th
- Talked to Linn at EMU and also Tracy and Pete at OU,
- We base cuts on state meet cuts, don't want to make meet cuts faster than D3 state meet.
- There are pros and cons to each site, the board decided to do a survey before the fall clinic abut this topic to the membership. Keep it at EMU for the 2009-2010 school year.
- Chuck and Shannon need to talk to EMU that we are considering moving the meet. And see what Peter is willing do to finalize meet operations.
- In talking to OU, need to see about having diving on Friday still. Can they run racing lanes east/west?

Diving

- Trying to streamline the entry procedure for state meet. Idea is to E-Dive for regionals that will carry over to state meet entries too.
- Rewriting the regionals meet managers packet to incorporate all the use of technology and procedures.

Dream Team

- If the kid doesn't send in info by set date do we want to skip them or just post the picture? No changes on form given to kids.

MHSAA Swim Committee

- Need to have grade level for all divers so we can make regional boundries based on graduating numbers.
- Entering state cuts from your team to MHSAA's site Chuck explained it is very time consuming, he suggested MHSAA using Hy-Tek, our board believes this will be "mandatory" but probably not enforced.

- MHSAA needs to improve the information sheet for the state meet entries, we strongly feel MHSAA needs to make sure each site if following the same entry procedure. We suggest three deadlines – coach to submit entries(Monday at 12noon), meet manger to send confirmation/entry report email(Tuesday at 12noon), and coach to reply with any changes to their entries(Tuesday at 9pm), and meet manager must post psych sheets(Wednesday at 12noon). Also suggested that we try to get all three state meet managers together for a nice dinner and conversation about how to streamline all this.

Middle School Meet

- Diving each school may enter 3 per event, a question was asked why can't we allow four divers in the diving event? Having the three limit per event allows more schools to participate. We feel its important to keep the swimming and diving entry limits the same.
- Meet went smoothly this year, it ran fast too, about same number of kids, Holt wants to run it again, doesn't know date yet.
- There still is a thought that this meet is a "state meet" and a sanctioned USA swimming meet. It is not an official USA swimming meet, therefore it doesn't go into their database.

Zone Realignment

- Zones will be realigned by early June, 2009.

MHSCA

- Asked again to be considered like baseball and exempt from the dead period
- Looking to allow 6th graders to compete
- Expand downtime for coaches to be two weeks before and after a season. Currently its just two weeks before the season
- They encourage us to submit hall of fame names. The President of our assoc should submit a letter with our recommendations/nominations.

NISCA

- Rule meeting regarding the suits they decided not to make a decision until the bigger governing bodies make their decisions.
- Full report is on the website
- They have given Rick Edwards a special recognition award
- All American online a coach can now give them the link to results instead of having to provide them results.

Academic Awards

- Individual All State recognition----This went well for a first time!
 - o 58 schools participated
 - o 164 athletes
 - o D1-74 kids-45%, D2-56 kids-34%, D3-34 kids-21%
 - o 119 applications (73%) were on time, 45 applications (27%) were submitted after the deadline
 - o 500 certificates were printed \$230.02
 - o This year's mailing costs were \$54.52
