### **Academic All State Individual & MHSCA**

We were able to honor 436 Seniors this year.  
Division break down:  
D1 198 athletes (45%)  
D2 95 athletes (22%)  
D3 138 athletes (32%)  
UP 5 athletes (1%)  
91 schools submitted athletes.  
93% of entries were submitted online.  
Twelve year total of 4,077 athletes honored.  
We will need to purchase certificates for next year.  
I will continue to accept submissions.  
Z will post a name fill in template on the website for filling in names.

### **MHSCA Info:**

Cost of insurance may have to go up.  
Insurance runs from August 1 - July 31. Insurance starts when you join MISCA. This is a huge benefit that comes with membership.  
We looked at our constitution to make sure words were more inclusive (not his or man).  
We are hoping for face to face Hall of Fame (September) and Coach of the Year (November) celebrations.  
The 2021 MHSCA Hall of Fame class will only have 5 inductees. This was done so that the 15 inductees from 2020 can still have a 'live' induction ceremony.  
Two swim coaches Tim McGinnis (Brighton) and Bob Oliver (Williamston) were inducted in the 2020 class.  
If you have 20 years of coaching, you are eligible for the MHSCA Hall of Fame. I would like to see more MISCA coaches submit applications. We have A LOT of deserving people that should be recognized.
